## **Top Takeaways**

#### Set YOUR Fleet's Vision

NREL will create an electrification plan specifically tailored to YOUR fleet; intended to reduce the burden of the electrification process whether it is experimental or mandated.

### Six Months From The Kickoff Call

All applicants will first receive a vetting call to ensure the electrification of YOUR fleet is realistic. After being accepted, NREL estimates YOUR fleet will have its own Electrification Transition Plan within 6 months of the kickoff call.

### **ODE TO SERVICE TO SER**

NREL expects ALL applicants to provide their fleet data (route data, scheduling, etc) and attend monthly meetings with NREL and its partners to ensure a plan that works for YOUR fleet.

### 🕖 Grant Preparedness

CBPA does **not** fund any deployment assistance but can help YOUR fleet stand out when applying for grants. CBPA directly *complements* the <u>EPA's Clean School Bus Program</u> and <u>FTA's Low-No program</u>, both require varying degrees of pre-project planning
